Subject: Freezing of Dearness Allowance to Armed Forces Officers and Personnel Below Officer Rank including NCs (E).

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure OM No. 1/1/2020-E-II (B) dated 23-4-2020 on the subject noted above and to say that in view of the crisis arising out of COVID-19, it has been decided that the additional installment of Dearness Allowance payable to the Defence Service Personnel due from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2020 shall not be paid. The additional installments of Dearness Allowance due from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2020 and 1<sup>st</sup> January 2021 shall also not be paid. However, Dearness Allowance at current rates will continue to be paid.

- 2. As and when the decision to release the future installment of Dearness Allowance due from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2021 is taken by the Government, the rates of Dearness Allowance as effective from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2020, 1<sup>st</sup> July 2020 and 1<sup>st</sup> January 2021 will be restored prospectively and will be subsumed in the cumulative revised rate effective from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2021. No arrears for the period from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2020 till 30<sup>th</sup> June 2021 shall be paid.
- 3. These orders are issued in line with Ministry of Finance OM No. 1/1/2020-E-II(B) dated 23.4.2020.
